

Naka Zora Pentatonic


The Naka Zora pentatonic scale is a Japanese pentatonic that is used over a Major7b5. It's spelling is $1\ 3\ \#4\ 5\ 7$. This pentatonic is derived from the notes of the Lydian scale, but can give a bit of a different sound, due to the absence of the 2 and 6, as well as it's angular shape on the fingerboard. Below are fingerings starting from each note of the scale, giving you coverage across the fretboard.








