
## Mixolydian Pentatonic

The Mixolydian Pentatonic, also known as Dominant 7sus4 Pentatonic is derived from the Mixolydian Scale. It's spelled 1 3 4 5 b7, which is a Dominant 7 arpeggio plus the 4th. In Mixolydian the 4th degree is generally considered an avoid tone, but also provides some color to the scale. The is a scale used frequently by Eric Johnson. Below are fingerings derived from each degree of the scale.
